## WINEMAKER'S SERIES 2006 CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Cabernet Sauvignon, the King of Reds, is a mainstay of the celebrated vineyards of France's Bordeaux region and also one of the most widely planted and esteemed grapes in the United States. The warm days and crisp evenings comprising the high desert climate of Idaho's Snake River Valley are ideal for producing exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon.

*Wine Description:* Full-bodied and flavorful, with abundant dark cherry fruit balanced by bright acidity.

*Winemaker Notes:* After crushing the grapes, we fermented the juice at warm temperatures with a full 10-day maceration to fully extract color and flavor from the grape skins. Once fermentation completed, the wine was lightly pressed off the skins, settled and racked into barrels for aging. Each barrel lot was closely monitored and only the finest were selected for

the final blend. One sip of this delicious wine confirms that Idaho is a prime locale for crafting world-class Cabernet Sauvignon.
